



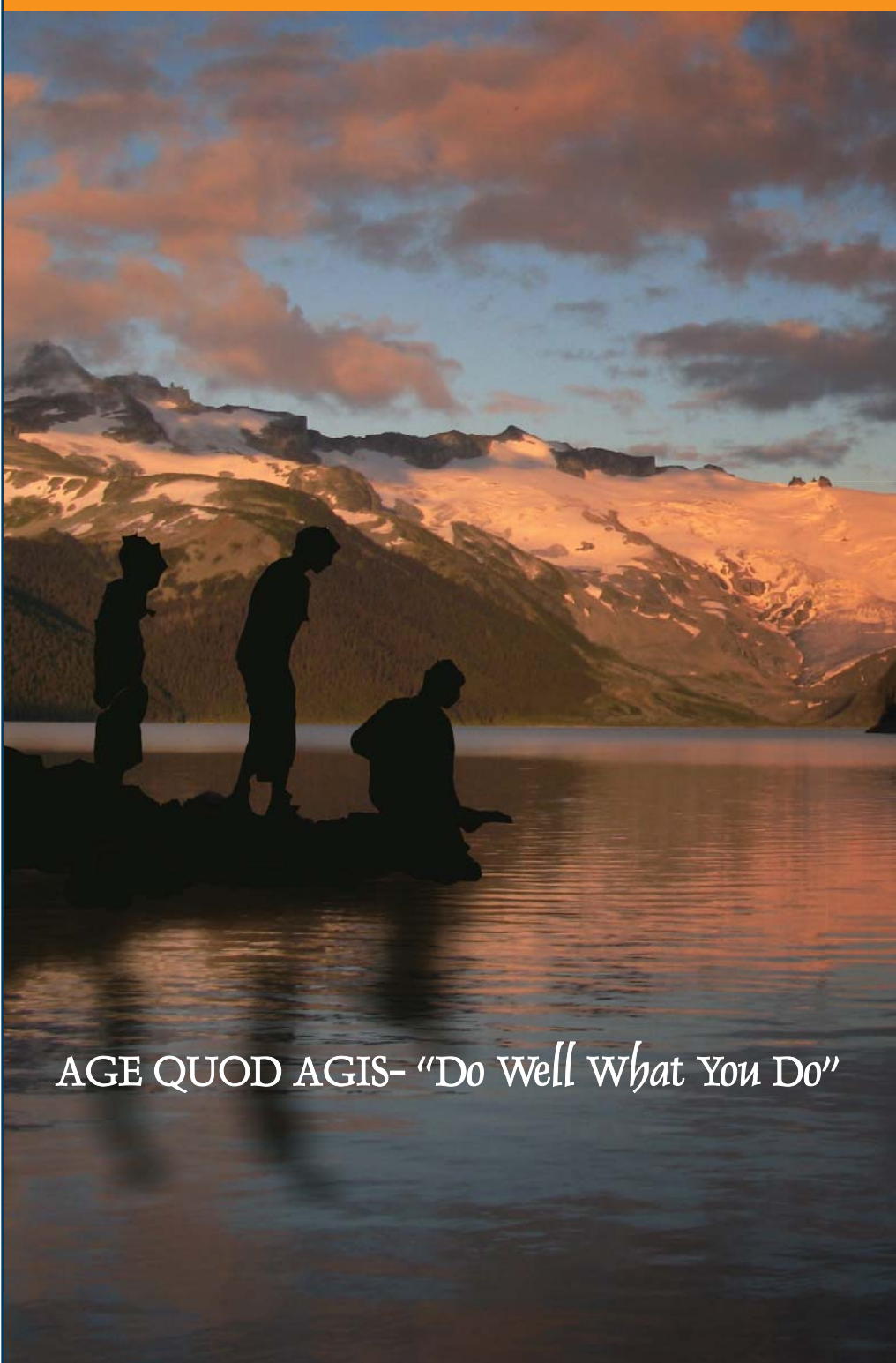

### PROGRAM COST
