## LEVEL STRUCTURE

The level structure for the children's program is based on 2 months and juniors programs is based on 3 months of curriculum per level, as outlined below:

- Level 1: Beginner
- Level 2: Novice
- Level 3: Low-Intermediate
- Level 4: High-Intermediate: *Required to enter Bridge schools*
- Level 5: **Advanced**
- Level 6: **Content Based Academics**

## EVALUATION & TESTING OUTLINE

1. Weekly tests of Spelling, Vocabulary and Listening Comprehension
2. One test every unit in Grammar (Minimum of one every two weeks)
3. Bi-weekly Writing assignments
4. One specially organized contest (Speech, Spelling, etc.) per month
5. Weekly Progress Reports

**KGIC incorporates Canadian Public School materials** in our Children's and Junior's ESL (English as a Second Language) Programs by making use of BC ELEMENTARY and SECONDARY SCHOOL books and ESL guidelines. This approach allows students to develop their English, so that the ability to speak, think and express themselves in the classroom all become an academic part of their communication skills.

By providing a general overview of the subjects they will encounter in a Canadian classroom while providing **intensive language**



**instruction**, the Bridge program makes the transition into public/private school easier and more successful.

**International students will be automatically granted admission** to these schools upon successful completion (Level 4) of KGIC's Children or Juniors Program.

Students are taught the **essential English language skills** they will need to succeed in Canadian elementary or secondary school classrooms.
